I spoke recently at a malaria conference at Ben Gurion University in the Negev (of Israel). While there I had the privilege of working with various people to construct a medical education program so that we could help educate villagers at the malaria free zones we establish in the basics of medicine. Each graduate of this three month course will be required to pass a board exam which will be administered by an international medical school program.
